

LANSTAR BREEDING CONTRACT FOR FROZEN SEMEN **SEASON OF 2017**

I hereby confirm my reservation to the stallion, ROC USA for the 2017 breeding season. I understand and accept the following terms:

It is the mare owner's responsibility to determine (by veterinary examination) that the mare is in sound breeding condition and free of infection. The buyer of this semen understands, and agrees to have the mare inseminated by a veterinarian experienced in equine reproduction who has access to a veterinary ultrasound machine, will breed the mare within 6 hours of ovulation, and will strictly follow the frozen semen thawing and insemination protocol furnished with the semen. Frozen semen requires extreme care in handling and the buyer understands that attempts to use frozen equine semen outside the controlled situation of the equine reproduction center can greatly reduce or even prevent chances of conception. It is highly recommended that only mares that are reproductively normal be used for insemination with frozen semen.

Further Terms and Conditions:

1. The buyer agrees to pay a \$350 non-refundable deposit that is due with the return of this contract along with a copy of the mare's registration papers. The deposit is applicable to the total purchase price of this contract. Total contract price is \$1500 stud fee plus \$350 booking fee. *All fees, charges and deposits due to the stallion owner must be paid before the delivery of semen.*
2. All semen transportation (shipping) costs are the responsibility of the mare owner. Any loss or damage to the container will be the responsibility of the mare owner. A FedEx account number, if available, and Visa or Mastercard number must be provided to be used for shipping costs. The container must be returned within 48 hours. Failure to comply will result in a late return container charge of \$20 per day.
3. The Buyer agrees to have the mare pregnancy checked by ultrasound examination within three (3) weeks after each breeding cycle during which the mare was inseminated and a pregnancy check by a licensed veterinarian 45 to 55 days after the last insemination and the mare passport must be filled out, signed and returned.
4. The mare owner understands and agrees to assume all responsibility for the condition of the mare and shall bear all risk of

loss, damage or injury to the mare from any cause whatsoever, and therefore agrees to hold the stallion owner or any person employed by or associated with the stallion owner, harmless for any injury or illness to the mare associated in any way with breeding using frozen semen provided by the stallion owner.

5. The Buyer specifically understands that the stallion owner makes no warranties or guarantees, either expressed, implied or by any other means of interpretation in connection with this agreement. The Buyer specifically understands that there is no foal guarantee with frozen semen provided by the stallion owner and further understands that the stallion owner shall be held harmless for any errors, failed inseminations, failure of the mare to conceive, failure of the mare to reach term, diseases or injuries to the mare, or any other mishaps attributable to frozen semen artificial insemination.
6. If the mare listed under this contract is unable to be bred, the mare owner, upon written request, can replace the mare only with the prior written approval of the stallion owner.
7. It is agreed that should the Mare be sold or change ownership after being bred to the Stallion, rebreed privilege will no longer be valid.
8. This Contract contains a "Live Foal Guarantee." A live foal is described as a newborn foal which stands and nurses. If a foal is born dead, there are return privileges for the 2018 season only if Lanstar is notified within 10 days and receives a veterinary statement confirming death. If after pronounced safely in foal the mare should miscarry, abort, or prove barren, the mare owner has the privilege to return her for breeding during the current breeding season or the following year, 2018.
9. A Breeder's Certificate will be issued for the foal when all fees have been paid in full and the Stallion Owner is notified that a foal has been born. Mare Owner will furnish Stallion Owner with a photo of the foal within the foal's yearling year. A Breeder's Certificate will be issued for additional foals conceived via embryo transfer or other method upon mare owner's payment of (an) additional contract(s.) Contract is for one foal from contracted mare only.
10. This Contract is entered into in the State of Wisconsin, USA and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of that State. In the event that it may be necessary for the Stallion Owner to employ an attorney to enforce the terms and conditions of this agreement, or as a result of the Mare Owner's breach, Mare Owner agrees to pay all reasonable attorneys fees, arbitration and/or court costs

expended by the Stallion Owner through and including the execution of any judgment(s).

11. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreements or promises, verbal or implied, are included unless specifically stated in this written contract.
12. Purchase of frozen semen is \$1,500 which entitles mare owner to two doses. \$750 for each insemination dose thereafter. Unused doses remain the property of the stallion owner and should be returned promptly once the mare is pronounced in foal.
